*Charter Boat service will be managed for the regattas.*

*The Italian Open National Circuit consist in 3 Events:*

- 1 Lago Di Garda Circolo Vela Arco 29th and 30th August 2020 ( National Event)*
- 2 Roma Lido di Ostia Tognazzi Marine Village 3th\_4th October 2020 (National Event)*
- 3 Roma Lido di Ostia Tognazzi Marine Village 10th and 11th October 2020 (Final Prize Giving of the National Circuit)*

*The final Ranking for a boat in the 2020 National Open Rs Aero Circuit will be the sum of the final positions in her best 2 Rounds out of 3. A boat's final position in a single Round will be as stated in the Round's final results provided by Local Organizing Authorities. The Prize Giving of Circuit will take place during the Prize Giving of the third Regatta.*

*“The regatta activities shall be performed in accordance with the provisions on contrast and containment of the diffusion of COVID 19 issued by the Federation that the Organizing Committees will activate and to which the participating members must comply under the supervision of the Organizing Committee itself. Any cases of COVID 19 that should be detected during the event will be reported by the Organizing Committee to the competent health bodies in charge”*

# Notice of Race

2. **PLACE AND DATE:** Rome - via Litoranea km 10,100 3th-4th of October 2020.

### 3. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS).

3.1 The Italian National Sport Regulations and its Prescriptions will apply. A copy of the Prescriptions will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

3.2 The International RS Aero Class Rules will apply.

3.3 The "PROTOCOL REGULATING THE MEASURES TO CONTRAST AND CONTAINMENT OF THE DISSEMINATION OF COVID-19 IN THE AFFILIATED SPORTS COMPANIES AND ASSOCIATIONS", version updated on June, 14th 2020 or any subsequent versions - hereinafter referred to as "PROTOCOL". An infringement of the "Protocol" may result in the application of a [DP].

3.4 The racing rules will be changed as follows:

-Rule 40 is changed so that personal flotation devices must be worn at all times while afloat.

-The Sailing Instructions (SI) may also change other racing rules. If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race, the Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes rule 63.7

-Boats may touch a mark other than the starting or finish marks. A boat shall not manhandle a mark when it results in an advantage. This changes RRS 31.

3.5 Racing boats shall not interfere with ferryboat, which always have right of way.

### 4. ADVERTISING[DP] [NP]

Competitor may be required from the organizing authority to display advertising, chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority following the W.S. Regulation 20.

### 5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

The regatta is open RS Aero 5, Aero 7, and Aero 9.

There will be allowed to participate any foreign crews, with a card of the national Federation to which they belong, if any.

Entries will be accepted by first come first served principle and the payment (by credit card, PayPal or by bank transfer) is mandatory at the moment of entry. No entry is valid if made without the following documents:

- RC insurance with minimum coverage as per FIV (Italian Federation) Regulations for the National Sports Activity organized in Italy 2020 (not necessary for Italians in possession of an FIV Plus card) see below point 7;
- COVID19 self-certification

**If the registration is completed with the payment and the documents sent, it is not necessary to go to the Race Office to sign any form.**

Italian sailors shall show their FIV membership card 2020 with valid medical certificate.

Foreigner sailors shall carry a similar card issued by their National Authority.

### 6. REGISTRATION:

6.1 Registration has to be made until September 28<sup>th</sup>, 11.59pm at the following website [www.tognazzimv.it](http://www.tognazzimv.it)

6.2 Entry fees have to be paid at the same moment of the registration paid by bank transfer to : to Tognazzi Marine Village A.S.D. Credito Valtellinese EU IBAN: IT26N0521603227000000000431 with these information:

- RS AERO 5 or 7 or 9 + name/surname + sail nr.

If paid until , 28<sup>th</sup> September at 23.59 the entry fee will be 40€ for one regatta and 60€ for the 2 regattas.

No payments can be done at the club office.

6.3 The requested documents shall be send also by E-mail to the club ( [segreteria@tognazzimv.it](mailto:segreteria@tognazzimv.it) )

6.4 Registrations made differently will not be accepted.

6.5 Anyone who has successfully registered via the website and sent all the required documentation in a single email to the above address will have no other documentation to submit. It will also not be necessary to sign the release form, accept privacy information and transfer photos and videos rights of the event.

6.6 By provision of the Protocollo, the race office will operate only in virtual mode and it will not be possible to deliver paper documents.

6.7 The official press releases will be communicated on the virtual notice board of the event.

## 7. INSURANCE

The boats shall hold a valid third-party liability insurance as provided under point "E.1 INSURANCE" of the FIV regulations for Sport Sailing Activity in Italy 2020, with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000,00 or the equivalent if expressed in other currency.

The valid insurance policy or a valid substitutive document must be sent by email at [segreteria@tognazzimv.it](mailto:segreteria@tognazzimv.it) before August, 19th 2020 with the sail n° and the name of the sailor.

8.1 The time of the warning signal of the first race on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> October 2020 will be given by a notice on the official ON-LINE notice board before 8 pm the day before it will take effect.

8.2 There will be done to 6 races per regatta, maximum 4 races per day. The series is complete with any number of race runs.

8.3 No warning signal will be given no later than 16.00 on Sunday, October, 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> .

## 9. SCORING AND PRIZES:

9.1 The scoring system is the "Minimum score system" described in Appendix A of the RRS. When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9.2 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 competitors of RS Aero 5, RS Aero 7, RS Aero 9 divisions and first girl of each division plus first 3 competitors RS Aero Master over 55.

9.4 The Organizing Committee reserves the right to define additional special prizes.

9.5 The prize giving will be celebrated as soon as possible after the conclusion of the single event, 3\_4 and 10\_11 October .

## 10. MEASUREMENTS:

Hull, sails, rigging and equipment used during the race will already be measured. The boats will race with the same sail number resulting on the measurement certificate; any changes must be approved in writing by the Race Committee; any checks may be carried out during the days of the regatta.

## 11. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on the website

## 12. COACHES & SUPPORTERS [DP] [NP]

All coaches and support persons shall be accredited by compiling the registration form available at the race office declaring:

- characteristics of their coach boat
- acceptance of the "rules for boats of assistance Coaches" described in the Sailing Instructions.
- List of competitors with the support person.

Coaches and support persons will be subject to disciplinary and technical guidelines of the Race Committee and the Protest Committee may repeal that permission to the presence on the race course. Every coach boat shall be provided with a WHF with channel 72 and 16, will have to display the flag/number of recognition given by the secretariat and will not bring more than 3 people on board, one of which under 18 years shall wear a life jacket.

**13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Competitors play the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. Competitors, person exercising parental authority and support persons, are responsible for the decision to take part or to continue the race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta, both on land and in water, as a result of their participation in the race referred to in this Notice of Race. Competitor will decide according to their ability, the strength of the wind, the sea state, weather forecasting, and everything else should be expected from a good sailor, if he go out to sea and take part in the race or to continue it to give up.

**14. PHOTOS RIGHTS AND/OR TELEVISION:** Competitors grant full right and permission to the Organizing Committee to publish and / or broadcast media by any means, any photograph or film footage of people or boats during the event, including but not limited to, commercials television and all that they can be used for their editorial or advertising purposes or for printed information.

**15. LOGISTICS - USEFUL INFORMATION - HOTELS OFFERING:** Competitors can transfer their boat from the Friday 2th of October until the 11th of October.
